CAMP LEJEUNE - INFRASTRUCTURE REPAIRS

Our federal division is making great progress on an infrastructure improvement project for Camp Lejeune. The work includes removing and replacing storm drain piping, structures, sidewalks, curbs, and gutters to enhance drainage and refresh the streetscape. Crews are also widening roads for uniform pavement width, preparing a new subbase for asphalt, and placing rip rap at storm drainage inlets and outlets to improve water flow. Additionally, we are backfilling areas where our subcontractor removed steam water piping, ensuring stability for the next phase. This project is advancing steadily, delivering quality and long-term sustainability for this critical military installation.
